

2013 PeeWee Interlock Rules

- Each inning there will be a 5-run maximum rule in affect and the last inning in the game will be open. If it's getting dark, the umpire will declare an earlier inning as the last and open inning.
- Time Limit: No new inning may begin later than 2 hours after the Official Start Time. Please ensure that speed of play and quick transitions are in place between innings.
- A 10 run mercy rule is in effect after 5 innings.
- Players cannot sit 2 innings in a row.
- All players should play in the infield at least once per game.
- Each team is responsible for fielding a complete team. In certain circumstances this does not always work out. A team has to field at least a minimum of 8 players or the game is forfeited. The game will be marked as a 6-0 loss.
- A copy of your team line-up is to be given to the plate umpire and base umpire at the start of each game, as well as a copy to the opposing coach.
- 1st year player has to pitch one complete inning (equivalent of 3 outs or a 5 run maximum)
- 1st year players need to be marked with an asterisk (*) on your team line-up.
- Home team uses the 3rd base dugout and the Away team uses the 1st base dugout.
- If a pitcher hits 3 batters in one inning, the pitcher must be removed from pitching for that game.

Rule 23: Pitching Rules

Number of Pitches and Required Rest:

1 – 35 pitches = no rest

36 - 55 pitches = 2 nights rest

56 – 76 pitches = 3 nights rest

See BC Minor pitching rules for pitch count limits.

Rest Rule Violation

If a pitcher pitches without proper rest as defined in Rule 23.01, the game will be forfeited to the opposing team.

Enforcement and Tracking

A) Managers will be responsible for tracking the pitch count of their pitchers and may assign this duty to their scorekeeper, assistant coach, etc. However, it is ultimately the manager's responsibility to ensure pitch count is followed.

B) Each team is responsible for maintaining a log of pitches thrown by their pitchers on the form provided by BC Minor.

A team may request to view their opposition's pitch count log prior to a game. A manager failing to maintain an accurate log may be reported to BC Minor and may face supplemental discipline including the forfeiture of games.

C) Under no circumstances will umpires be expected to track or enforce pitch counts.

Head First Slides

No head first slides to a base or home plate are allowed in PeeWee. All offending players will be automatically called out. (Diving head first back to a base already acquired will be allowed)/

Playing up Game Limits

Players being called up are not allowed to pitch.

The maximum number of games a player may play in an older age group (to include league and/or exhibition and/or tournament and/or playoffs) will be as follows:

Mosquito – 3 games plus one tournament at the PeeWee level only.

PeeWee – 3 games plus one tournament at the Bantam level only.

If a player exceeds the number of games allowed as defined in rule 4(a) above, the player cannot return to their division for the balance of the year, including all league, playoffs, zone and provincial competition.
