Formula applied to all the teams. The top two teams ranked by formula advance. No tie-breaking game is played.	Tie-breaking criteria used for the 3 teams tied for 1st with 3-1 records. If all team won against each other, formula will determine the number 1 ranked team, and the other teams will play a breaking game.	Head-to-Head record used for the two teams tied at 3-1.
