

PROVINCIAL TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS
PLAYERS' INSTRUCTIONS

Officials of B.C. Babe Ruth Baseball and the hard working Host City Officials have made extensive efforts to make certain your stay will be pleasant and rewarding. Therefore, we shall expect that you fully co-operate with the following regulations pertaining to your personal conduct during the tournament.

SPECIAL NOTE: Host team players are subject to all requirements and activities also.

1. ASSISTANCE - We want all players to enjoy themselves during the tournament. If you need any information or assistance, contact your team manager immediately.
2. TOBACCO / ALCOHOL / DRUGS - SMOKING or CHEWING of TOBACCO is strictly PROHIBITED during tournament play or at any social function connected with the tournament.

POSSESSION or USE of any ALCOHOL beverages under any circumstance during tournament play or at any social function connected with it is strictly PROHIBITED. Possession or use of any alcohol beverages SHALL be cause for immediate disqualification from the tournament.

No player shall possess or use any ALCOHOL beverages under any circumstances during tournament play or at any social function connected with the tournament. Use of same SHALL be cause from immediate disqualification from the tournament.

POSSESSION or USE of any DRUG, excluding prescribed medical drugs, during tournament play or at any social function connected with it is strictly PROHIBITED. Possession or use of any non-prescribed drug shall be cause for immediate disqualification from the tournament.

3. UNACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOUR - Unacceptable behaviour shall include unsportsmanlike conduct, breaking curfew, willful damage to property, committing any action considered an offense under the law or not abiding by the tournament rules as outlined by the Host Committee.
4. CONDUCT - Your conduct on and off the playing field must be above reproach. Any misbehaviour or misconduct could not only cause your disqualification from the tournament but could also disqualify other members of the team or the team as well.

IF Host Families are needed, then:

All players are to be in their Host Family's home no later than one (1) hour after the day's last scheduled activity or tournament game. If an event or game goes beyond 12:00 midnight, all non-participating team members will return to the Host Family's home. There will be no one (1) hour grace period.

DO NOT request money, gifts or special favours from your Host Family.

DO NOT charge any long distance telephone calls to your Host Family.

DO NOT use any appliance, electronic, computer, mechanical or recreational equipment or items without prior permission from your Host Family.

Under no circumstances are you permitted to drive the Host Family's vehicle or any other borrowed vehicle.

You will be held responsible for any damage caused by yourself to the Host Family's or Tournament Host Site's property.

If you leave your Host Family's home without good cause, become involved in a situation that warrants ejection from that home or disregard established curfew times you will be subject to disqualification from further tournament play.

Disregard for any of these regulations or guidelines shall be sufficient grounds for players or team officials to be withdrawn from the tournament and sent home at the expense of the individual player or his team.
