

Kennedy Little League Invitational Tournament

Rules of play for 2010

Welcome to Kennedy Little League, Madison WI

Home team will be determined before the game with a coin flip.

Please have your line-up ready 15 minutes prior to game time. There will be an official scorekeeper for each game.

Your roster needs to be turned into the tournament director before your first game and is then frozen for the duration of the tournament.

If it is possible to start a game early we will to keep the tournament on schedule.

There are NO protests allowed, final decisions will rest with the umpires and tournament directors.

Little league rules apply to bats and equipment.

NO infield before any game, NO EXCEPTIONS

Courtesy runner can be used for the catcher with 2 outs, the last player making the out being the runner.

Time limits will be enforce so hustle your teams on and off the field.

All umpires are experienced and registered with Wisconsin District 4 LL Baseball, and are not directly associated with Kennedy LL.

In case of inclement weather the tournament directors have the right to change the format of the tournament. All decisions made by the tournament directors are final and will be made in the best interest of all teams, players, and families involved. In case the tournament is cancelled due to weather, a prorated refund will be mailed to the teams coach.

13 /14 yr old tournament

Coaches may bat their entire roster if they so choose, if not, LLB substitution rules apply. Player substitutions must be done through the home plate umpire and official scorekeeper.

Little League Junior league rules apply

Games are played on a full size diamond, 90' bases, 60'-6" pitching mound

All games will be 7 innings or 2 hrs in length, In case of a tie at the end of regulation play or full inning past the time limit, at the start of the next inning the player making the last out will be placed at 2nd base to begin the inning.

10 run rule after 5 complete innings, 15 run rule after 4 complete innings is in effect.

Runners must avoid contact by sliding when necessary. Players initiating excessive contact in the opinion of the umpire can be ejected for the remainder of the game.

Pitching Rules

A pitcher may not pitch more than 3 innings in a game. A pitcher may not pitch in consecutive games except if they pitched 1 inning. An inning is defined as a single pitch.

A pitcher cannot pitch more than 12 innings for the tournament.

10, 11, 12 yr old age groups

Coaches may bat their entire roster if they so choose, if not, LLB substitution rules apply. Player substitutions must be done through the home plate umpire and official scorekeeper.

Little League rules apply.

Games are played on a LL size diamond, 60' bases, 46" pitching mound

Leading off before the pitch has crossed the plate will result in the runner being called out at the conclusion of the play. EX: Runners on first, and third, 2 outs, runner on first leaves early, batter hits ball to outfield scoring runner at third, runner from first also scores on play, batter to 2nd. Result: runner on third score counts, runner from 1st called out for leaving early not scored as run, 3 outs, inning over. EX.: Runner on first nobody out, runner leaves early on pitch that gets past the catcher, runner ends up on third. Result: runner out for leaving early, 1 out in inning.

Stealing of all bases including home is allowed.

No on-deck batters, No swinging of bats outside the fences

Warming up pitchers must be done inside the fences

There is an adequate area for teams to warm up before the games, do not throw balls in pedestrian areas.

Runners must avoid contact by sliding when necessary.

All games will be 6 innings or 1:30 hrs in length, In case of a tie at the end of regulation play or full inning past the time limit, at the start of the next inning the player making the last out will be placed at 2nd base to begin the inning.

10 run rule after 4 complete innings, 15 run rule after 3 complete innings is in effect.

Pitching Rules

A pitcher may not pitch more than 3 innings in a game. A pitcher may not pitch in consecutive games except if they pitched 1 inning. An inning is defined as a single pitch.

A pitcher cannot pitch more than 12 innings for the tournament.
