- ❖ This is a 17-U tournament with **NO GRADUATED PLAYERS**. Players may use **Wood or Wood Composite bats ONLY**.
- ❖ We will be having pool play to determine seeding into the Sunday bracket games for the top 4. Friday's games are non-pool play games that won't impact pool standings. Saturday's games are the pool play games that will determine seeding for Sunday.
- ❖ All games are scheduled to be 7innings, the 8 run rule will be in effect after 5innings. No new inning will begin after 2 Hrs. 15 Min. from start of play (Site Director on clock). Pool play games can end in a tie. Start with a runner on 2nd base (last out the previous inning) with no outs each inning beyond the 7th.
- ❖ There will be no pregame warm-ups(infield/outfield) on the fields to help alleviate the amount of use they will receive.
- ❖ We will be playing high school baseball rules to maximize playing opportunities. Re-entry and courtesy runners will be allowed for the pitcher and catcher. EH is ok as well.
- ❖ Tie-breakers for seeding purposes will be head to head first. Then it will be least runs allowed, run differential followed by a coin flip if necessary.
- ❖ Home team will be determined by coin flip unless you play I-5 Jeep or I-5 Toyota Mt. Dew they are home for pool play games. I-5 Jeep and I-5 Toyota Mt. Dew will have first base dugout when playing at Bearcat Stadium and Tiger Field.
