LOCATIONS: David Story Field on the campus of Lower Columbia College, Longview WA 98632. Enter from Olympia Way entrance, free parking in any lot around entirety of complex. **SECONDARY FIELD:** Mark Morris High School. Shares a parking lot with LCC, located adjacent to LCC Baseball CF, beyond LCC Head Start Complex.

WHAT: Teams will play 3 pool play games that will determine seeding for the crossover style "Championship Round" that will take place on Sunday June 20th. Each team will play 4 games total (3 pool and 1 seeded game on Sunday. Number 1 seeds from each pool will play each other, as will numbers 2's, number 3's and number 4 seeds from each pool, etc. There will be no true "championship round", only a 4 game guarantee.)

RULES AND TIE BREAKERS: 2 Hour Drop Dead or 7 Innings, whichever comes first. Normal high school rules and substitutions, courtesy runner allowed for catcher and pitcher if they are hitting. DH and EH can be used, can bat 9 or 10 but normal HS subbing still applies. *Best Overall Record determines placement in Sunday Games. First tiebreaker is Runs allowed and second tiebreaker is runs scored. If a third tie breaker becomes necessary, a coin-flip between teams will be administered, winner takes the higher seed .* **METAL SPIKES ARE OK!**

PRE-GAME HITTING/WARM UP AND GAME BALLS/FOUL BALLS: 1 hour prior to each game the batting cages will be open for use by teams. Scheduled home team (listed on bottom of each matchup) will get the first 20 Minute slot, then visiting team gets the 20-minute slot immediately following home team, still leaves 20 more minutes for additional warm-up, and catch play on field before game starts. Garage door of hitting barn must remain closed if a game is currently going while your team is hitting. Home team pitcher must be ready at scheduled game time unless a change in game time is noted by tournament director/site supervisor. Balls provided in Cages by Lower Columbia College, **DO NOT REMOVE!** If game is at Mark Morris, their cages are near tennis courts beyond LCC Baseball RF. The tournament will supply all game balls. **Each team is responsible to HELP shag foul balls on their respective sides based on dugout they are in.**
