- **Code of Conduct**
 - Review code of conduct for coaches, players, spectators & parents
- **Uniforms**
 - Player's uniforms have been ordered. Player's will receive the sizes that they tried on. Any player that has not been fitted will receive the size that was on the registration form. Any player that has not paid for registration fees will not receive a uniform until fees are paid.
 - Some sizes, in certain colors may be backordered. Your player will receive the next size up if this occurs.
- **Concession Stand Duty**
 - Each team will have a set concession stand schedule during game nights. Each team must have 2 parents cover a 1½-hour shift during their game time. Recommended to break it up into 4 parents (2 parents for the first 45min and 2 parents for the second 45min so no one misses the whole game) this schedule will include the majors and juniors division.
 - If a team fails to have concession stand coverage the game will be halted until the team has coverage.
- **Fundraiser**
 - All players that have not opted out MUST participate in the league fundraiser. If a player does not turn in fundraiser monies he/she will not be allowed to play until full balance is collect.
 - Fundraiser start date is Tuesday October 13th. Fundraiser monies are due Monday November 2nd.
 - Fundraiser tickets will be giving to your head coach/team mom. One completed your team mom/coach will collect the fundraiser monies as a team.
 - Separate raffle for the player who sells the most ticket books.
 - The drawing of the prizes will be conducted during the skills challenge competitions on Saturday, November 7th.
- **Equipment**
 - **Glove** – Players can use any glove that is appropriate for them.
 - **Bats** – (Rookies – Majors) the bat may not exceed 33 inches length, and the bat barrel may not exceed 2¼---inch diameter. Only 2¼---inch barrel non---wood bats marked BPF 1.15 will be allowed. Wood 2¼ barrel bats are allowed. T---ball bats are not recommended for Rookies divisional play, as the speed of the ball will dent the bat. Juniors may use BBCOR bats.
 - **Helmets** – All players must have a helmet with a face mask. (excluding Juniors)
 - **Cups** – Cups are recommended for all players. ALL catchers and pitchers in ALL divisions WILL be required to wear a cup.
 - **Cleats** – Are not mandatory but are recommended. Soft spikes until juniors divisions

 - T-Ball photos are schedule for Saturday, October 24th.
